





The **Downtown Seattle Transit Tunnel** is the first tunnel of its kind in the United States to be used by both buses and light rail simultaneously.

Tunnel hours of operation:

Monday - Saturday: 5:00 am - 1:00 am Sunday: 6:00 am - Midnight

Sound Transit Light Rail to/from Sea-Tac Airport:

Fare: \$2.50 for adults, \$2.00 for ages 6-18, free for 5 and under. Travel time: approx. 37 minutes. The last stop for light rail is the Westlake station; light rail trains do not stop at Convention Place. See www.soundtransit.org for complete details.

Metro Bus Ride-Free Area:

All buses (but *not* light rail) are free to ride from 6:00 am - 7:00 pm daily between any of the stations on the tunnel:

- Convention Place
- Westlake
- University Street
- Pioneer Śquare
