





Tunnel hours of operation:

Monday - Saturday: 5:00 am - 1:00 am Sunday: 5:00 am - Midnight

Sound Transit Light Rail to/from Sea-Tac Airport:


Fare: \$2.50 for adults, \$2.00 for ages 6-18, free for 5 and under. Travel time: approx. 37 minutes. The last stop for light rail is the Westlake station; light rail trains do not stop at Convention Place. See www.soundtransit.org for complete details.


Metro Bus Ride-Free Area:
